

8-Day Motorbike Tour in Corsica – Best-Of Itinerary with Daily Hotel Stays

8 days/7 nights

An 8-day complete motorbike tour of Corsica, with daily hotel changes, allowing you to discover all the island's highlights. From Bastia to Bonifacio, passing through Calvi, Piana, Ajaccio, Corte, and Bavella, you'll be amazed by the variety of landscapes, the rich local cuisine, and the warm welcome awaiting you. This touring road trip promises a full and unforgettable experience. Welcome to Corsica, the motorcyclist's paradise!

YOUR PROGRAM

Day 1 - The Cape of Corsica

Upon arrival in Bastia, set off to explore Cap Corse. Begin along the gentle coast, stopping at Erbalunga and Maccinaggio, then cross the cape, enjoying spectacular cliffs and hidden coves. Pause in Canari or Albo, admire the Paoline tower and its black pebble beach, before reaching Corsica's wine capital and your overnight stop with white sand beaches. Distance: approximately 130 km.

Overnight in a 3-star hotel in Saint-Florent.



Day 2 - From St Florent to Galéria

Cross the Désert des Agriates along winding roads, past olive groves and typical villages. The scenery becomes almost lunar before reaching Balagne with its breathtaking views. Stop in Belgodère, then follow the Artisans' Route through perched villages, ending in Calvi and the coastal village of Galéria.

Distance: approximately 160 km.

Day 3 - From Galéria to the Calanches de Piana

Today's ride takes you to the Col de Palmarella for stunning panoramic views. Descend a cliffside road and pass through charming villages, then head to the Calanches de Piana and admire villages with Greek-influenced architecture. Continue along the coast before heading inland, watching out for wild pigs and goat herds. Stop in Evisa, famous for its chestnut trees, before finishing the day in a spectacular natural setting.

Distance: approximately 150 km.

Overnight at a 3-star hotel.



Day 4 - From Porto's bay to Corte

Today, explore a charming village known for its Genoese bridges and olive groves. Reach the highest road point in Corsica, then descend to a peaceful lake. The stunning Scala di Santa Regina leads nearly into Castagniccia, where winding roads stretch for kilometers. Finish the day by reaching your overnight stop in Corte.

Distance: approximately 130 km.

Day 5 - From Corte to Valinco's bay

Today, take the main Corsican route through the Vizzavona Forest, offering stunning views. In Ajaccio, stroll through Napoleon's hometown and visit the Pointe des Sanguinaires, with its white sandy beaches. Continue along the coastal road, ascend among the eucalyptus to a former penitentiary, then pass through the small villages of the Taravo before reaching your overnight stop in Propriano.

Distance: approximately 180 km. Overnight in a 3-star hotel.



Day 6 - Bonifacio and Bavella

Today, head to Sartène, then continue through semi-desert landscapes to the spectacular cliffs of Bonifacio. Ride along some of Corsica's most beautiful beaches, with opportunities for river swims. Then ascend to the island's heart via the famous Bavella Needles, before descending into Alta Rocca for your overnight stop in Zonza.

Distance: approximately 175 km.

Overnight in a 3-star hotel in Zonza.

Day 7 - From the Alta-Rocca to the Costa Verde

Today, explore typical villages, olive groves, and old mills. Cross beautiful mountain passes and spot free-roaming animals such as pigs and horses. Ride through extensive forests and visit Ghisoni with its small ski resort, before taking the Inzecca gorge road and descending to the plains for your overnight stop in Prunete.

Distance: approximately 148 km.

Overnight in a 3-star hotel.



Day 8 - Back to Bastia

On the final day, explore Castagniccia, a lush region with perched villages and scenic panoramic roads. Then skirt the Biguglia Nature Reserve and its lagoon, where flamingos are often seen. The tour concludes upon your arrival in Bastia. Distance: approximately 130 km.
