From winding coastal roads to dramatic mountain passes, this adventure combines spectacular riding, rich local culture, and stunning natural landscapes. Whether you're seeking thrilling curves, crystal-clear waters, or charming villages, this tour offers the perfect blend of freedom, exploration, and pure riding pleasure.

YOUR PROGRAM

Day 1 - Arrival in Bastia

Arrive in Bastia, Corsica, and settle in for your first night on the island. If you have rented a motorbike locally, this is the time to pick it up and get ready for your upcoming adventure.

Day 2 - Explore the Cape of Corsica

After your arrival in Bastia, start your Corsican motorcycle adventure by exploring the stunning Cape of Corsica. Ride through the rolling hills of Northern Corsica, stopping at the charming ports of Erbalunga and Macinaggio before continuing along the scenic cape.

Next, follow the coastal road to Centuri, renowned for having some of the best crayfish in France, and discover its magnificent hidden coves. You may also choose to stop in Canari or Albo before heading to Nonza, famous for its Paoline Tower and dramatic black-pebble beach.

End the day in Patrimonio, the heart of Corsican wine country, before reaching your hotel in St Florent, where you can relax and admire the beautiful sandy beaches.

Overnight: 3-star hotel in St Florent



Distance: Approximately 130 km



Day 3 - Ride Through the Désert des Agriates and Balagne

Today's stage takes you through the Désert des Agriates, one of Corsica's most remarkable protected nature reserves. Enjoy winding roads and breathtaking landscapes as you pass through olive groves, cactus trees, and Barbary figs. Explore charming mountain villages where cows roam freely and soak in the ever-changing scenery on your way toward Balagne, transforming into a lunar-like panorama at sunset. Stop briefly in Belgodere to admire a quaint church before continuing along the Route des Artisans (Road of the Craftsmen).

Next, ride to Calvi, taking time to admire its historic citadel and bustling port. Continue along one of Corsica's most famous scenic roads, known for its dramatic views, before reaching the seaside village of Galeria, where you will enjoy dinner at a local gîte d'étape.

Overnight: 3-star hotel in Galéria

Distance: Approximately 150 km



Day 4 - From Galéria to the Calanches de Piana

Today's stage begins with a climb to the Col de Palmarella, offering spectacular panoramic views over Corsica's rugged landscape. Descend along a scenic cliff road, passing rolling grasslands and picturesque villages, where you can stop to relax



and enjoy a drink. Continue toward nearby seaside villages, perfect for experiencing a variety of water sports.

Next, ride to the striking Calanches de Piana, exploring the village's churches and admiring hints of Greek influence in its architecture. Follow the coastline before heading inland, keeping an eye out for wild pigs that often roam freely on the roads. Continue to Evisa, renowned for its chestnut forests, and finish the day riding through gorges where herds of goats are frequently seen.

Overnight: 3-star hotel in Porto

Distance: Approximately 150 km



Day 5 - From Porto's bay to Corte

Today's ride takes you through scenic Corsican roads to an enchanting village renowned for its Genovese bridges and olive groves. Continue toward Corte, climbing the island's highest road, before descending along an undulating route that leads to a picturesque lake nestled in the mountains.

The journey continues along the Scala di Santa Regina, guiding you to the Castagniccia region, where miles of twisting roads offer endless opportunities for exploration. Along the way, enjoy panoramic views, traditional villages, and the authentic charm of Corsican landscapes. End the day in Corte, where you can relax at your hotel and reflect on a full day of riding through mountains, forests, and scenic villages.

Overnight: 3-star hotel in Corte

Distance: Approximately 150 km



Day 6 - From Corte to Valinco's bay

Today's stage takes you along Corsica's main scenic road, passing through the lush Vizzavona Forest with its towering trees and serene landscapes. Arrive in Ajaccio, Napoleon's birthplace, and enjoy a stroll through its historic streets before visiting the Pointe des Sanguinaires, a dramatic coastal area surrounded by white sandy beaches.

Continue along a coastal road lined with eucalyptus trees, offering stunning views of the Mediterranean, and pass an ancient prison that hints at Corsica's rich history. Your ride then leads through the charming villages of the Taravo region, where local life and traditional architecture create a unique atmosphere. End the day in Propriano, relaxing at your 3-star hotel after a fulfilling day of winding roads, cultural highlights, and spectacular scenery.

Overnight: 3-star hotel in Propriano

Distance: Approximately 169 km



Day 7 - Bonifacio and Sardinia

Today's ride takes you through Sartène and the sun-baked hills of southern Corsica, passing arid landscapes and charming villages along the way. Reach Bonifacio, famous for its dramatic chalky cliffs, and take the ferry to Sardinia (approx. 1 hour) to continue your adventure.



Once on the island, follow coastal roads with breathtaking sea views, exploring picturesque villages and hidden coves along the way. End the day at your 3-star hotel in Castelsardo, where you can relax and enjoy the first evening of your Sardinian ride.

Overnight: 3-star hotel in Castelsardo

Distance: Approximately 150 km



Day 8 - From Castelsardo to Tresnuraghes

After breakfast, ride along Sardinia's stunning coastal roads to visit Alghero, a charming town known for its historic center and Catalan-Gothic architecture. Continue your journey through scenic landscapes, passing ancient churches, sparkling lakes, and hidden sea caves.

Follow the winding roads to Bosa, a colorful town famous for its riverside houses and vibrant old town, before heading to your seaside hotel in Tresnuraghes, just a five-minute walk from the beach. Enjoy a relaxing evening after a day filled with breathtaking scenery, cultural highlights, and unforgettable riding experiences.

Overnight: 3-star hotel in Tresnuraghes

Distance: Approximately 140 km





Day 9 - From Sardinia's western beaches to the mines of the South

Today's ride takes you along scenic beach roads toward the south of Sardinia, a wild and lesser-known region of the island. Explore abandoned mining villages, once home to Sardinian miners, and admire the pristine beaches and sand dunes of the Costa Verde.

Continue your journey through rugged landscapes and charming coastal scenery, before reaching a quaint town rich in history and local character, where you will spend the night. Reflect on a day filled with off-the-beaten-path discoveries, cultural highlights, and memorable riding experiences.

Overnight: 3-star hotel in Buggerru

Distance: Approximately 150 km



Day 10 - The Great South

After breakfast, embark on a ride exploring the southern tip of Sardinia, a region of stunning natural beauty. Discover a protected natural park, home to a variety of bird species, and enjoy the chance to visit an old mine or explore an underground cave. Take some time to relax along the white sandy beaches of this unspoiled coastline.

In the evening, return to your hotel in Iglesias, reflecting on a day filled with scenic roads, unique wildlife, and memorable Sardinian landscapes.

Overnight: Second night in Buggerru

Distance: Approximately 140 km



Day 11 - Towards the East Coast

Today's stage takes you across Sardinia from west to east, exploring exotic Nuraghe ruins, picturesque villages, and magnificent inland lakes. Ride through Orgosolo, a village renowned for its murales, political murals that vividly depict Sardinian life and culture.

Continue your journey toward one of the island's most famous thermal spas, enjoying scenic roads and lush landscapes along the way. In the evening, arrive at your 3-star hotel in Cala Gonone, where you can relax after a day filled with culture, history, and stunning inland scenery.

Overnight: 3-star hotel in Cala Gonone

Distance: Approximately 160 km



Day 12 - From Cala Gonone to Arzachena

Today's ride takes you along Sardinia's most scenic coastal and inland roads, passing through Dorgali, a charming town known for its traditional architecture and nearby Gennargentu mountains. Continue toward Olbia, an energetic city offering a mix of history, culture, and Mediterranean charm.

Along the way, enjoy hidden coves, turquoise waters, and dramatic granite landscapes, with opportunities to stop in small villages and experience authentic Sardinian life. Finally, reach Arzachena, famous for its archaeological sites and as the



gateway to the renowned Costa Smeralda. Relax at your 3-star hotel, reflecting on a day of breathtaking scenery, cultural discoveries, and unforgettable riding.

Overnight: 3-star hotel in Arzachena

Distance: Approximately 150 km



Day 13 - From Sardinia to Corsica

After breakfast, ride north along Sardinia's scenic coastline toward Palau, where you have the option to take a boat excursion to the Maddalena Islands, a breathtaking archipelago renowned for its turquoise waters, hidden coves, and pristine beaches.

Continue your journey to Santa Teresa di Gallura, then take the ferry back to Bonifacio in Corsica. From there, follow winding mountain roads into the Alta Rocca region, discovering traditional villages and enjoying authentic Corsican landscapes. End the day in Zonza, staying in a charming guesthouse, and reflect on a day full of coastal adventures, island exploration, and scenic mountain rides.

Overnight: Guesthouse in Zonza

Distance: Approximately 160 km



Day 14 - From Zonza to Bastia




After exploring the charming villages, olive groves, and historic mills of the Zonza region, set off along spectacular mountain passes, where you may encounter free-roaming pigs and horses. Ride through dense forests and rolling landscapes, enjoying the ever-changing scenery of Corsica's interior.

Stop in Ghisoni, a quaint town known for its mountain resort, before continuing toward the Inzecca Gorge, a dramatic natural passage offering breathtaking views. Follow the road through Moriani and onward to Bastia, where your journey concludes. Reflect on a day filled with twisting roads, mountain panoramas, and authentic Corsican culture.

Overnight: 3-star hotel in Bastia

Distance: Approximately 190 km



Day 15 - End of trip

After breakfast, enjoy some leisure time in Bastia before returning your motorbike if you rented one locally. Take the opportunity to stroll through the historic streets, visit local shops, or enjoy a last coffee in one of the charming cafés of the town.

Your Corsica and Sardinia motorcycle adventure concludes here, leaving you with unforgettable memories of scenic coastal roads, winding mountain passes, charming villages, and stunning Mediterranean landscapes.
